



## Election and Voting Info

### No matter where you live in the county, you can vote for Anne

- Each commissioner resides in one of three geographic districts, however ...
- Commissioners are elected at large (by registered voters across all three districts), and serve the entire county

### Anne's election will take place on June 25, 2024

- Both Anne and her opponent are Democrats, so the District One race will be decided during the June 25 Colorado primary
  - Registered voters will receive paper ballots by U.S. mail in early June
- The winner of the primary will advance to the general election on November 5, but there are currently no candidates from other parties

### You must be registered **Democrat** or **Unaffiliated** to vote for Anne

### Every vote truly counts – especially in our small county

- The Wilkinson Public Library construction ballot measure **passed by 1 vote!**
- The recent Telluride mayoral election was **decided by 10 votes!**

### Confirm/update your registration online ASAP – [www.govotecolorado.gov](http://www.govotecolorado.gov)

- Double-check your mailing address – the place you will be in early June; *the post office cannot forward ballots*
- Confirm your party affiliation – if you want to vote for Anne, choose **Democrat** or **Unaffiliated** (you can change this again after the primary, if you'd like)
